

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced the allocation of supplemental funding to the 2017 Federal Allocations for the Emergency Solutions Grant program to assist communities who lost significant capacity to serve the homeless in recent years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Savannah, Georgia expects to receive a total of \$823,801 from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development in the form of Emergency Solutions Grant funds for fiscal year 2017; and

WHEREAS, it is a condition for receipt of such funding that the City submit to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development a substantial amendment to the 2017 One Year Action Plan, as adopted November 10, 2016, and

WHEREAS, the City of Savannah seeks to disperse its supplemental allocation of \$639,157 among Inner City Night Shelter (\$60,000) and Family Promise of Greater Savannah (\$85,000) for homeless shelter services. Request for proposals will be issued for remaining shelter and homeless prevention funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah authorize Rob Hernandez, City Manager, to submit to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development the City's amended One-Year Action Plan for 2017 and to enter into grant agreements with the subrecipients named therein.
