

Population Boom: Highlands-Benton


Population History

- 2010 Census:
 - ~2,800 residents

**Projected population = Total Residential Units x Average Household Size			




Highland Business Park Properties

★ East Broughton Street Properties


East Broughton Street Properties

PINs 2-0005 -20-001, -002, -003, -005 & -006



- 0.68 Acres
- Acquired for parking garage.
 Building new garage at Eastern
 Wharf, so site is longer needed.
- Encumbered by parking reservation

Feeley Avenue Properties



- Vacant Industrial Lands located along Railroad
- Originally acquired for flood plain mitigation.
 No longer need these parcels.
- Has wetlands and debris

DEAL POINTS

- Land Exchange Contract
 - Provide both parties 90 days due diligence
- Appraisals to be updated based on due diligence findings:
 - Wetlands
 - Debris
 - Parking Encumbrance
 - Etc.
- City will only exchange if the appraised value of property received is greater than appraised value of property to be exchanged.
