The following information is being supplied on an official basis concerning the Original Alcohol Beverage License application of **King Chan**. A security plan has been submitted by the applicant and reviewed by Savannah-Chatham Metropolitan Police Department.

The security plan was examined to ensure it properly addresses all mentioned concerns in the City of Savannah's 2017 Alcohol Beverage Ordinance, Section 6-1206, Subsection D, Paragraph 4, Items A-I, as applicable.

In reference to the petition for **King Chan** requesting a **Class C (retail dealer, distilled spirits, malt beverage and wine, consumption on premise) and Sunday Sales** permit at 8 East Broughton Street, T/A "Sapporo Japanese Cuisine", I submit the following:

King Chan's Security Plan has been reviewed. SECURITY PLAN ASSISTANCE SHEET:

SAPPORO JAPANESE RESTAURANT:

1. Open Mon-Sun Hours: Mon-Th-11am-10pm/Fri-Sat-11am-11pm/Sun 12pm-10pm
2. We are a restaurant so everyone inside is seated except the patrons at the front which we have a waiting area.
3. We are on Broughton Street so there is no designated parking, they can park through the street or garages.
4. We do not have designated parking due to being on Broughton Street so we do have means to control the areas. We have a hostess/manager at the front who sees who comes in and out of the restaurant however.
5. No we do not use security guards.
6. We make sure we ask everyone for their ID's no matter the age.
7. Yes we allow everyone in our Restaurant and we make sure we ID everyone who asks for an alcoholic beverage.
8. We don't cook with fire but if there is an accident our hood is equipped with the proper Ansel System and it will go off if fire reaches it.
9. We will try to evacuate out the front door. Managers at the front and sushi bar will be in charge of escorting people out. We do not currently work with the police or EMS.
