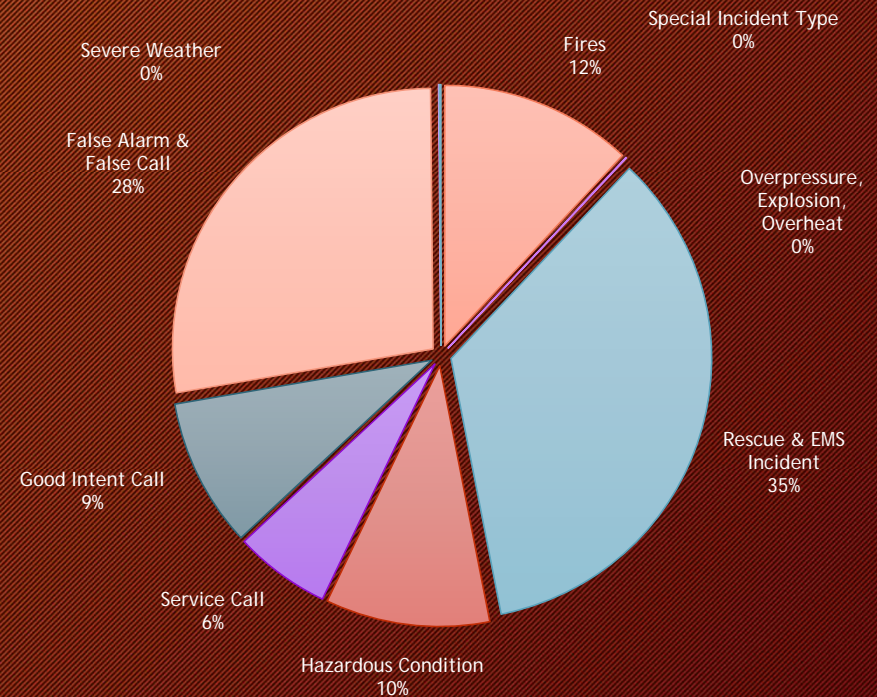


3rd Quarter Overview (July- September)

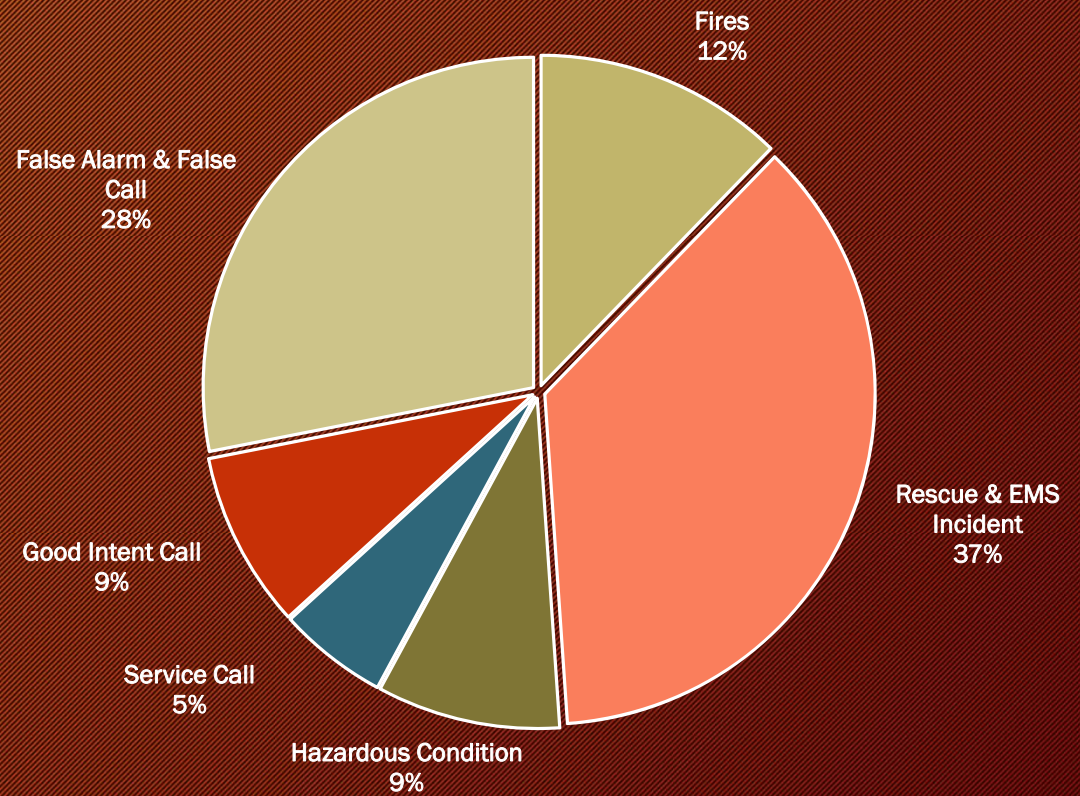

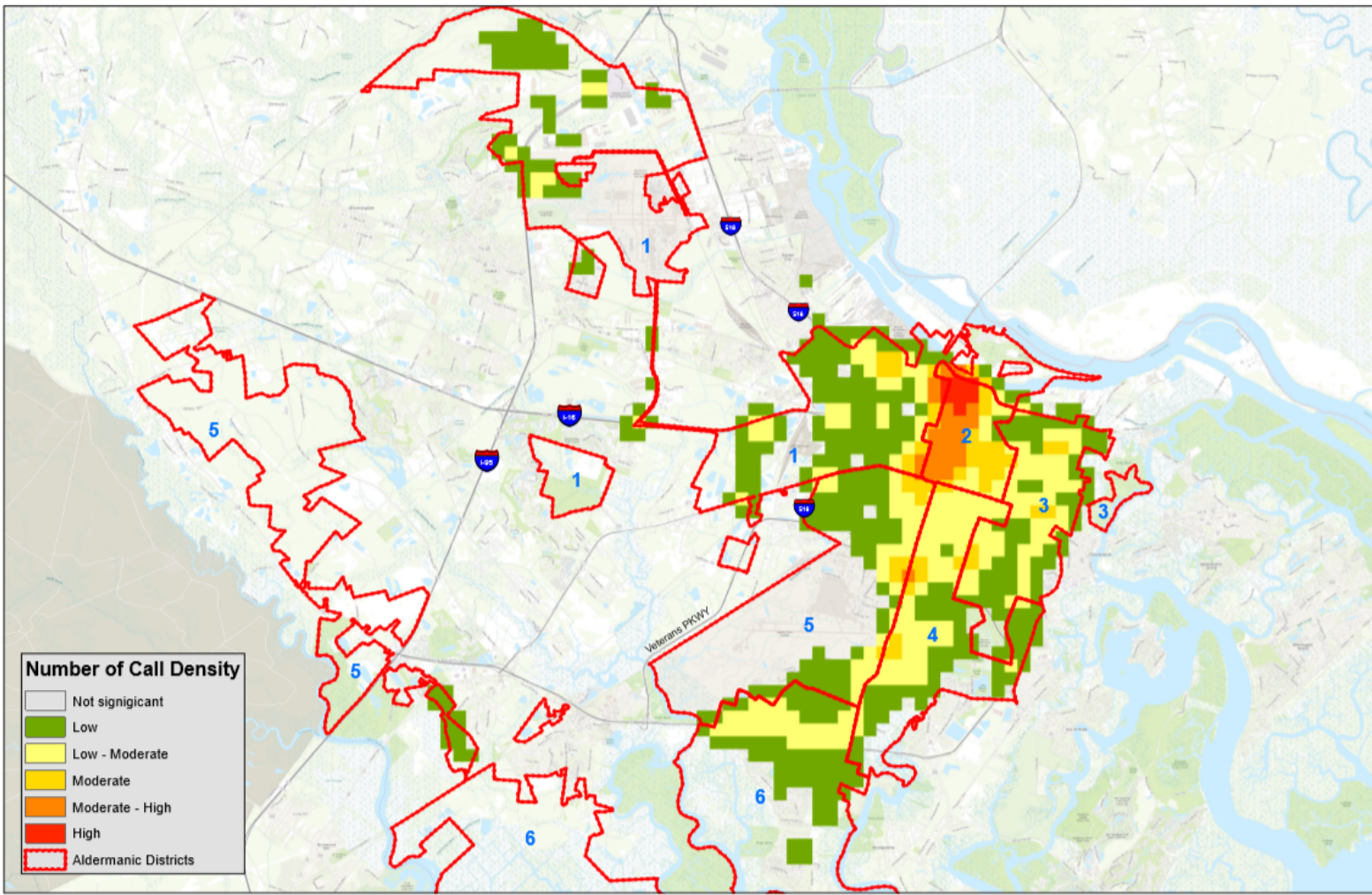

SFD's 3rd Quarter Overview

- The final edits are being completed on the 2020-2024 Strategic Plan
- City Wide Risk Assessment is 98% complete
- Annual Compliance Report for CPSE Accreditation was accepted
- Received NASBLA reaccreditation for Marine Program
- Awarded DHS/GEMA grants for Technical Rescue and Haz Mat - \$120,000
- GSFA performed audit of training records – compliance was confirmed
