


Berkshire Study Recommendations (In Progress)

- ➤ Plans to address longer-term technology investment needs (IT strategic plan submitted) Progress is continuing, recent purchases of both hardware and software will improve police response such as; County wide RMS /CAD, Smartforce, Digital warrant signing,
- Steps to reduce salary compression (Awaiting Pay and Comp)* Upon Council approval, Pay and Comp will complete this task
- Assess the need to provide incentives for officers to accept centralized investigative assignments (Review after pay and comp)
- ➤ Electronic time tracking (2019-20) In the funding request from OMB Pending Council Approval (pilot will start with the Police Department)
- ➤ Develop case file management alternatives (Currently meeting with IT and vendors to identify solution) Still in

progress, Dec-Jan we will piloting new AXON system







