





# **Goal Setting Recommendation**

- Recommended Data Sources (DOT):
  - GDOT Contractor Directory
  - GDOT UCP Directory
  - Previous M/WBE and DBE participation
  - DOT national DBE goal of 10%
  - City of Savannah 2016 Disparity Study
- Recommend 20% overall DBE goal with 10% local DBE (LDBE)
