EVENT # 5056 - Oils, Lubricants and Anti-Freeze

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe various oils, lubricants, and antifreeze for use by Vehicle Maintenance and other City departments. All fittings shall conform to AWWA C-800 and NSF 61 NO- LEAD compliant.

To submit pricing electronically for this event, enter pricing for each line item shown under the lines tab on the event summary. To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form.

4.1 <u>Detailed Specifications</u>:

- 4.1.1 Only major brands, (i.e.: Exxon Mobil, Chevron, Texaco, Shell Citgo, Pennzoil, Conoco Phillips, Castrol) **NO** private label / house brands will be accepted.
- 4.1.2 Vendors are asked to provide alternate pricing for environmentally friendly oils made from re-refined base oils will be acceptable as long as they meet all the same standards as oils made from virgin crude, and meet all major manufacturers' approval. The award will be for one product or the other not both.

- 4.10 Red Heavy duty extended life anti-freeze for diesel engines, extended life full organic acid technology. Contains additives for cylinder liner protection and coolant system life. Must meet CAT-EC1 performance specifications with 750,000 mile change interval.
- 4.11 Global automotive extended life anti-freeze formulated to be compatible with all colors and types of anti-freeze on the market. 5 year, 150,000 mile protection.
- 4.12 Allison Transynd TES 295 Synthetic Transmission Fluid (27101-CTDR-Transynd) in 55 gallon drums.
- 4.13 All oils and lubricants required under this contract are for equipment and vehicles which are under repair. Therefore delivery time is critical. The City of Savannah reserves the right to make purchases from other the contract vendor on a case-by-case basis when deemed that the contract vendor's delivery time to be unacceptable. Quantities shown on the bid proposal are estimates only for the City of Savannah.
- 4.14 Oils requested in bulk to be delivered into the City of Savannah's bulk oil storage tanks by vendor. Delivery must be made within twenty-four (24) hours of order placement. Delivery to various locations will be required.
- 4.15 Additional purchases will be required for oil and lubricants not covered on the bid proposal form. Pricing of these items should be consistent with the lowest pricing offered by the vendor to their best customer.
- 4.16 Quantities given are based on previous years' usage. Actual quantities purchased may be more or less.
- 4.17 Bidders must provide the name of the manufacturer and specific data as to the following properties of the antifreeze based upon the Standards prescribed by the American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM).
- 4.18 Bidders must submit pricing of items based on the unit of measure indicated for each item.
- 4.19 Due to the historical price volatility of oils and lubricants this contract will allow for price changes on a quarterly basis. Specifically a quarterly review will be conducted jointly between the successful vendor(s) and the City of Savannah to determine the current market trend. Based on this review, the price paid will be adjusted, up or down. If an agreement cannot be reached, the City reserves the right to award the contract to the next low bidder or rebid the contract.
- 4.20 <u>Delivery</u>: All prices should be FOB Savannah, Georgia, 31401, 31406 and 31415. Unit prices should include all delivery and handling charges. Quantities stated are based on prior usage and are <u>estimates</u> <u>only</u>. The City reserves the right to purchase more or less than the estimated quantities.

Deliveries will be required to three (3) main locations:

- (1) Fleet Maintenance located at the corner of Stiles Avenue and Gwinnett Street. They will order bulk and drums approximately 4 times a year. (2). Central Warehouse City Lot, 1100 W. Gwinnett Street, Building C. This site will order case quantities. (3). Vehicle Maintenance 6900 Sallie Mood Drive. This site will receive bi-weekly deliveries of bulk and drums. This site may require 24 hour turnaround on emergency orders.
- 4.21 **Basis of Award:** This contract will be awarded to the vendor that offers the lowest net price to the City, and who meets or exceed all specifications herein. The City reserves the right to split the award if deemed to be in its best interest. The City also reserves the right to appoint a primary and secondary vendor if deemed advantageous.

The City reserves the right to split the award should it be deemed in its best interest.

5.0 **GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS**:

- 5.3 To submit and be awarded bids, vendors must be registered as suppliers on the City of Savannah's website at www.savannahga.gov.
- 5.4 Bidders must provide the manufacturer's name and part number of each item bid in the space provided on the bid form.
- 5.5 This is an annual contract and prices are to be held firm for a period of one (1) year (12 months). This agreement may be renewed for up to two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods, if all contracting parties so agree and services provided by the vendor have been satisfactory.

SECTION 01310 DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS EMPLOYMENT PROVISIONS

The City of Savannah actively encourages employment and participation of small and disadvantaged businesses in all City contracts. Attention of the bidders is called to contract conditions contained herein pertaining to non-discrimination, equal employment opportunity, subcontracts, and opportunities for project area residents.

It is the policy of the City of Savannah that disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs) be given fair opportunity to participate in the performance of services for the City, and that prime contractors utilize DBE subcontractors and suppliers to the fullest extent possible consistent with the efficient performance of the contract. The City of Savannah has established an 18% DBE goal for this project.

In order to determine compliance, bidders shall submit the following completed documents in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked with the bid number, project name and number and marked (Section 1310 Disadvantaged Business Employment Provisions) with their bid:

The contractor is required to fulfill any DBE utilization commitments made unless good cause is demonstrated for any failure to fulfill such commitment. **Written approval is required prior to any substitution**.

The contractor will maintain records and information necessary to document compliance with Good Faith Effort requirements, and the City shall have the right to inspect such records.

Any DBE listed in the completed form entitled "Proposed Schedule of DBE Participation" (Section 01310-4) must be certified by an approved agency such as USDOT, GDOT, or SBA 8(a) prior to the due date of this bid. Proof of DBE certification such as a certificate or letter from the certifying agency is required to accompany the bid. A firm that has submitted an application for DBE certification or an application for DBE certification under review but has <u>not</u> been certified is <u>not</u> qualified as a certified DBE and will not be recognized as such during the City's evaluation process.

No bidder shall enter into an agreement with any DBE that would in any way limit the DBE's opportunities to sell to, or act as subcontractor for, any other party. Violation of this requirement would be grounds to deem the bidder non-responsive to this bid solicitation.

Instruction for Completing Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Form

O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia's cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain "public benefits" are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the City are considered "public benefits."
