#### PUMP REPAIR FOR STORMWATER

#### **EVENT NO. 7083**

#### SPECIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4.0 The purpose of these specifications is to describe requirements for submersible, axial flow pumps for the Stormwater Management Division of the City of Savannah. These pumps are used for flood control and as such time is of the essence in their repair.

To submit pricing electronically for this event, enter pricing for each line item shown under the lines tab on the event summary. If submitting electronically, submit the total amount for line item #2 as the materials cost (\$12,000) plus the percentage markup cost (ex. If your markup is 10% you would enter \$13,200 as your total markup cost). Bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered. To enter pricing manually, complete the attached bid proposal form. Manually submitted bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms contained in these specifications in order to be considered.

A pre-bid conference has been scheduled to be conducted at the Purchasing Office, 301 West Oglethorpe Avenue, Savannah, Georgia, 31401. This meeting will allow contractors to discuss the specifications and resolve any questions and/or misunderstandings that may arise with City staff. You are invited to attend.

- 4.1 Pumps to be covered include large, submersible, axial flow pumps manufactured by Flygt with model numbers PL 7121.935 and PL 7115.900.
- 4.2 Inoperable pumps shall be picked up by the successful vendor within 24 hours after notification. Pumps shall be identified by pump station name and location, pump tube location number, model number, and serial number.
- 4.3 The successful vendor will be responsible for determining the cause of the malfunction, making an initial diagnosis prior to removal of the pump and making the necessary repairs. The successful vendor shall assist City staff in removal and subsequent reinstallation of each pump repaired. The nature of the problem and possible cause shall be documented to the City of Savannah. The successful vendor will determine estimated repair costs for each unit and fax the estimate to the City. If estimated repair costs exceed 60% of the price for new equipment, the City may elect at its sole discretion to replace the entire unit.
- 4.4 For more involved repair work requiring electrical and/or machine shop capabilities, it will be the responsibility of the successful vendor to provide this service, either directly or through a subcontractor. A single invoice and purchase order including unit price per item shall be provided. If subcontractor is used, a copy of the subcontractor invoice showing labor and material costs must be provided.
- 4.5 The City reserves the right to have motor rewinding work performed under existing contracts.
- 4.6 Pricing shall be submitted for labor and materials needed to make repairs. Hourly labor costs shall include all miscellaneous tools and equipment commonly found in a large machine shop, (including but not limited to:, lathes, milling machines, welding machines, burning out-fit-torches, grinders, regular small hand tools, vehicles, etc.), all skill levels, and any overtime premium involved. Travel time to and from the job site and travel time to procure parts shall not be included in hours charged to the City. Parts pricing shall be based on

a percentage markup from vendor procurement cost. This percentage markup shall be submitted on the bid proposal form.

To verify contract pricing, the successful vendor will be required to provide backup data such as labor time sheets, vendor invoices, etc. All invoices must have a description of the work performed, the number and rate for all labor hours, and the quantity and price for all materials. A written job summary must be included with each invoice. It shall include each day's activities and materials installed as part of the job. Also, vendor invoices for parts/materials shall be included with each invoice. Delivery tickets will not be accepted as verification for payment.

- 4.7 Each bidder shall submit with its bid a list of service personnel, showing service time, qualifications received, and any other pertinent information relating to staff qualifications.
- 4.8 All repair parts used must be original equipment manufacturer (OEM) or approved equal for use on the model of pump involved.
- 4.9 All repair work shall carry a non-prorated warranty covering parts and labor for a period of 12 months from the date of invoice.
- 4.10 All pumps and motors shall be repaired and delivered within 30 calendar days of receipt from the City, excluding documented parts delays.
- 4.11 The City may award this contract to both a primary and a secondary vendor if deemed to be in its best interest. The City reserves the right to request time and material estimates on any pump repair job. In the event an estimate is deemed excessive, the City, at its option, may award the job to the secondary vendor. If In the event the primary vendor consistently exhibits excessive hourly requirements, (and/or materials), the City reserves the right to award the contract to the next low bidder or re-bid the contract.

#### 4.12 Qualifications

- 4.12.1 Repair facility shall be located within the state of Georgia.
- 4.12.2 The facility's primary business will be pump repair.
- 4.12.3 The facility shall be equipped with lathes, welding equipment, and milling machines for parts manufacture.
- 4.12.4 The facility shall have a dynamic balancing machine capable of balancing up to 10,000 pounds.
- 4.12.5 The facility shall have mechanics certified in pump repair and maintain an emergency phone number 24-hours a day, seven days a week.
- 4.12.6 Response time shall be a maximum of one hour for call outs.
- 4.12.7 The facility must have at least one laser alignment machine.
- 4.13 This contract includes transport and rebuild of the submersible axial flow pumps as well as removal and installation of the same. Gantry cranes are installed at all pump stations for the purpose of pump removal and loading onto transport trucks.

#### 4.14 Insurance Requirements

Comprehensive General Liability

Contractor shall carry comprehensive general liability on an occurrence form with no "x, c or u" exclusions with the following minimum limits:

- Each occurrence \$1,000,000
- Damage to Rented Premises \$50,000
- Medical Expense \$5,000
- Personal & Adv Injury \$1,000,000
- General Aggregate \$2,000,000
- Products Completed Ops. Aggregate \$2,000,000

General aggregate shall apply on a per project basis.

Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.

A waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate.

A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate.

#### 4.14.1 Commercial Automobile Liability

The automobile policy must include coverage for owned, non-owned and hired automobiles.

- Minimum limits are \$1,000,000
- Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.
- Waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate.
- A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate.

#### 4.14.2 Workers Compensation

Contractor shall carry a workers compensation policy including all statutory coverage required by Georgia state law.

Minimum employer's liability limits:

- \$500, 000 each accident
- \$500, 000 each employee (disease)
- \$500, 000 policy limit (disease)

Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.

A waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate.

A (30) day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate.

#### 4.14.3 Umbrella/Excess Liability

Contractor shall carry an umbrella/excess liability policy which must follow form over underlying policies: general liability, auto liability and employer's liability.

Minimum limits: \$1,000,000 per occurrence \$1,000,000 aggregate

Contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance reflecting required coverage.

Waiver of subrogation endorsement to the policy in favor of the City shall also be provided and attached to the certificate.

A 30 day notice of cancellation in favor of the City must be endorsed to policy and attached to the certificate.

#### 4.14.4 General

All insurance shall be placed with Georgia admitted carriers with a current Best's rating of A(minus), X, or better.

Any modifications to specifications must be approved by the City.

- 4.15 The City reserves the right to award this contract to primary, secondary, and tertiary vendors. Secondary and tertiary suppliers may be selected to fill orders if the primary supplier cannot make provision to the City when time is of the essence.
- 4.16 This is an annual contract. Prices shall remain firm. This agreement may be renewed for up to three additional 12 month periods, if all contracting parties so agree and services provided by the vendor have been satisfactory. The first term of this contract shall begin upon award and shall end on December 31, 2019. All remaining renewal options, if exercised, shall begin on January 1 and end on December 31 of each subsequent year.
- 5.0 General Conditions
- 5.1 The bid response shall include all documents required in the bidder's checklist.

All referenced documents must be completed and returned in their entirety to constitute a complete bid.

- 5.3 The vendor is responsible for determining and acknowledging any addenda issued in connection with this bid solicitation. All addenda issued for this event must be acknowledged in order for a bid to be considered.
- To be awarded bids, vendors must be registered as suppliers on the City of Savannah's website at www.savannahga.gov.
- 5.5 This contract will be awarded to the vendor offering the lowest net price to the City, and meeting or exceeding all specifications herein.
- 5.6 All bids must be submitted in **DUPLICATE**.

## Instruction for Completing Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Form

O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia's cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain "public benefits" are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the City are considered "public benefits." Therefore, the successful bidder will be required to provide the Affidavit Verifying Status for City of Savannah Benefit Application prior to receiving any City contract. The affidavit is included as part of this bid package but is only required of the successful bidder.
