Number/Utilization of Security Personnel:

The Old Savannah Distillery will not have uniformed officers on a regular basis. Staff, such as management, bartenders, servers, and bar backs, will be responsible for security, as well as the management staff of the restaurant.

Checking ID and Controlling Entrance to Underage:

Employees will only accept valid government issued identification. Bartenders and servers will request ID when serving/selling alcoholic beverages. If an employee checking an ID has a strong suspicion that an ID is fake, altered, or is not the individual presenting it, he/she will confiscate it and turning it over to management to be presented to police. There will be a Global ID book on site. All employees will be TiPS certified.

Control and Public Safety Concerns

The restaurant and bar areas will be outfitted with numerous security cameras, on both the interior and exterior of the building to monitor and report activity. Security alarms will be also used to close and open. The staff will reserve the right to refuse service to anyone they feel is a danger to the facility, others, or themselves and the police will be called for any disturbances or criminal activity.

Fires, Evacuations, Assignments of Duty, Coordination with Public Safety:
