OPERATING AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT FOR SERVICES

This Operating Agreement and Contract for Services ("Agreement") dated January _____, 2019, ("Effective Date") is by and between THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SAVANNAH, ("CITY") a Georgia municipal corporation, and COASTAL HERITAGE SOCIETY ("CHS"), a Georgia non-profit corporation.

WHEREAS, the CITY and CHS (the "PARTIES") entered into a prior Management Agreement for the operation, maintenance, and use of the Tricentennial Park property ("PREMISES") effective as of January 1, 2017 for a one year period that expired on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the prior Management Agreement provided a one year extension that expired and terminated on December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City and CHS are seeking to extend the terms, conditions, and services of the prior Management Agreement for a short-term period of 90 days in order to provide time for the bidding and contracting associated with a longer term plan for the use, management, and maintenance of The Premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions set forth herein, the adequacy, sufficiency and receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, the CITY and CHS agree as follows:

- The terms, conditions, and services previously provided in the Management Agreement are hereby extended for a three-month period, from January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019; and
- 2. Funding will continue to be paid from the CITY to CHS at the previous contract rate; equating to a one-time payment for the quarter of \$179,132.01; and
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the previous Management Agreement will remain the same during the extension period.
