## A Resolution of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah Supporting the Commissioning of the Littoral Combat Ship USS Savannah (LCS-28)

**WHEREAS**, on February 5, 2022 the United States Navy will officially commission the Littoral Combat Ship USS Savannah (LCS-28); and

WHEREAS, this ship is the sixth Navy warship to bear the name Savannah; and

**WHEREAS,** The USS Savannah (LCS-28) is part of the Independence Class of littoral combat ships designed to be a smaller, agile, more multipurpose warships that operate near shorelines; and

**WHEREAS,** the *Savannah* is designed as an anti-submarine warfare vessel carrying a mixture of MH-60 Helicopters and Fire Scout unmanned aerial vehicles; and

**WHEREAS,** she will have over 400 feet in length displacing 2307 metric tons with an operating crew of over seventy and an aluminum tri-hull ship design capable of top speeds in excess of 40 knots; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah take great pride in supporting the commissioning of USS Savannah (LCS-28).
