To Whom It May Concern,

In accordance with the City of Savannah Code of Ordinances 'Section 4-1102.- Naming new facilities or public property', I am requesting that the land located north of Abercorn Street and south of the Abercorn Frontage Road be named Veterans Memorial Park.

The property is located adjacent to the southernmost end of the Harry S. Truman Parkway and is bounded by Abercorn Street to the south and east, and Abercorn Frontage Road to north and west. The property's land is comprised mainly of grass with a few trees on the west end.

This property is owned by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). GDOT has formally agreed to allow the City of Savannah to name this property. The property originally served as an apartment building called Plantation Oaks Apartments but was demolished to allow for the construction of the Phase V of the Truman Parkway.

The name Veterans Memorial Park is recommended to honor all military veterans who have and continue to serve the United States of America. This location is important because of its position on a highly visible thoroughfare which helps highlight our commitment to remembering and honoring past and present veterans.

Hi Joe,

We found no duplication of names for either naming request in our records in the Archives.

Regarding the Windsor Park name request, my only comment is regarding the consideration of an alternate name of "Windsor Forest Park." The neighborhood's name is Windsor Forest and this is well documented in historical records in both the Municipal Archives' map collections, Metropolitan Planning Commission's neighborhood files, and the Georgia Historical Society's manuscript collections. Windsor Road is one of the main roads in Windsor Forest and an argument could be made that like the road, the park takes simply Windsor from the more complete name. I don't necessarily think that one name is better or more right than the other. I just think that it bears some additional consideration and discussion.

If you would like a brief historical summary of Windsor Forest neighborhood let me know and I can supply that.
