- How to improve the quality of life for downtown residents as it relates to the trolley cars.
- Trolley car routes, how does it effect tour guides sharing history of the City.

- · Parking of tourism vehicles in the downtown area.
- Possibility of updating the noise ordinance.
- Timeline of making any changes as directed in the ordinance.
- State law as it relates to the protection of industries that create noise.
- City Manager Melder will provide a report to Council Members on the trolley tour sound ordinance within the next two-four weeks.
- Horse drawn carriages
  - Horse drawn carriages as it relates to traffic safety.
  - Placing restrictions on the carriage operations.
  - Banning/transitioning from the horse drawn carriages.

  - When other cities banned, what was the outcome.
  - City Manager Melder will prepare a report for Council Members showing case studies from other cities. Timeline for the report is sixty days.
