

The purpose of this memorandum is to submit recommendations effective 11/13/2025. The following information is being supplied on an official basis concerning a new Alcoholic Beverage License for William Hall. A safety plan has been submitted by the applicant and reviewed by the Savannah Police Department.

The safety plan was examined to ensure it properly addressed all mentioned concerns in the City of Savannah's Alcohol Beverage Ordinance, Section 6-1206, Subsection D, Paragraph 4, Items A-I (as applicable).

In reference to the petition for William Hall requesting a Class C distilled spirits, malt beverages, and wine by the drink with Sunday sales at 48 Whitaker Street, Savannah 1875 Pub LLC, DBA Circa 1875, I submit the following:

William Hall's safety plan has been reviewed. It should be noted, the safety plan addresses all applicable concerns set forth by the governing sections of the City of Savannah's Alcohol Ordinance. The Savannah Police Department has no reason(s) for recommending denial of this safety plan.

- 1. Identification of days and hours of operation.
- Monday through Sunday: 11:00 AM 10:00 PM
 - 2. Specific measures and procedures to address crowd management, both within and outside the premises.
- A manager or floor supervisor is always present during operating hours.
- All staff trained in crowd management, de-escalation, and evacuation procedures.
- Host monitors entry and ensures occupancy limits are not exceeded.
- Reservation system used to regulate guest flow during peak times.
- Maintain clear walkways and exits; no obstruction of sidewalks or doorways.
- Signage directs guests to restrooms, exits, and waiting areas.
- Regular coordination with local Fire and Police as needed.
 - 3. Identification of any parking areas either owned or controlled by the licensee. N/A
 - 4. Means of controlling access to the premises and parking areas.
- Adhere to Fire Marshal-approved occupancy limits.
- Only primary entrance used for guest access; other doors locked from outside but open from inside.
- Security cameras monitor all entry and exit points.
- After hours, all doors secured with locks and alarm system activated.
- Exterior lighting and camera surveillance remain active overnight.
 - 5. Security Staffing.
- Security personnel hired only during high-traffic holidays (St. Patrick's Day, Fourth of July, New Year's Eve).
- On regular nights, management and host staff handle guest monitoring.

- 9. Where applicable, discussion of measures the licensee will undertake to visibly distinguish between patrons under and over the age of 21.
- All patrons ordering alcohol must present ID.
- Patrons under 21 are not served alcohol under any circumstances.
- Managers and floor staff monitor for compliance.
