

The purpose of this memorandum is to submit recommendations effective **5/2/2024.** The following information concerns the Alcoholic Beverage License Application for **Leonard Johnson.**

The petitioner is requesting a change of responsible party for the alcohol licensing of a Class C123SS(Restaurant) for on-premises consumption of distilled spirits, malt beverages, and wine with Sunday Sales at Better Than Sex Tres, INC advertised as Better Than Sex A Dessert Restaurant located at 410 West Broughton Street.

A review of the criminal history of **Leonard Johnson** to be found on file with the Alcohol Beverage Compliance Unit revealed no disqualifying information as outlined in the City of Savannah Code of Ordinances, Section 6-1207, b.6. Based solely on the applicant's criminal history, the Savannah Police Department recommends approval of the above petition.
