The use permit for Squirrel's Pizza was approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals under the previous zoning ordinance (18-001079-ZBA). According to Sec. 1.4.4.b of the current zoning ordinance, permits approved under the old ordinance are regulated according to the standards of that ordinance. The use permit for restaurant with alcohol sales and for bar, nightclub or tavern remains in effect through change of ownership as long as the business tax certificate does not lapse for more than one year and the business is not abandoned for more than one year. The current request meets this requirement. The parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District. Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen (see above).
