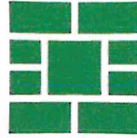

In reference to the application of **Christopher Emerick / DBA Two Cracked Eggs Café** requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **202 E Bay St** (PIN 20004 11006), I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant and Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol)**, within the current **D-W (Downtown Waterfront)** zoning district:

I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s)**:

- Restaurant is permitted by right.**
- Is Not Permitted
- Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen
- Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol) is permitted as a Limited Use with Standards. Use is limited to on-premises consumption only. However, the property is located in the Open Container Zone.**
- Is Permitted as a Non-conforming Use

Further, I have determined that **Parking** at the property:

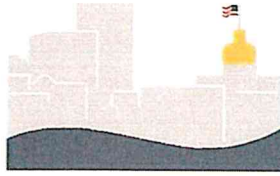
- The parking is exempt / met (Downtown & Pre-existing use).**

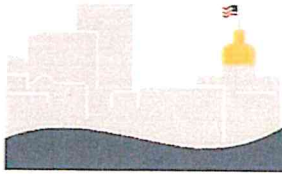
