Re: Zoning Review of Alcoholic Beverage License Request 20-006361-ABL

In reference to the application of **Cristine Tindall, T/A Café M**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **128 East Bay Street**, I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s); *Restaurant with Retail consumption dealer (on premise consumption of alcohol)***, within the current **D-W Zoning District**:

I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s)**:

- Is Permitted by Right**: The principal use, *Restaurant*, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is a use permitted by right in the zoning district.
- Is Not Permitted.
- Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen.
- Is Permitted as a Limited Use with Standards**: The principal use, *Retail consumption dealer (on premise consumption of alcohol)*, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is allowed as a limited accessory use with standards. Article 8 Sec. 8.7.24 requires that the requested principal use limit alcohol sales to on-premises consumption only. There are no other use limitations that apply.
- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use.

Additionally, I have determined that the **Proposed Use**:

- Is an Existing use/occupancy, but new ownership, management or request.**
- Is a New use/occupancy.

Additionally, I have determined that the **Location** has:

- Zoning Ordinance violations that need to be corrected prior to the issuance of the Alcoholic Beverage License.
- The parcel has a recent Business Location Approval application, approved October 19, 2020, for a Coffee Shop (Pre-existing 15-004507-BA) under the Food-oriented retail use classification per File No. 20-004647-BA.**


