Dear Martin:

The purpose of this letter is to request the transfer of the City-owned property located at 1836 and 1838 Kolloch Street (PINS: 20067 05016 and 20067 05015) to the Chatham County/City of Savannah Land Bank Authority, Inc. (Land Bank) for future sale and conveyance to support the development of affordable and workforce housing.

Upon successful acquisition of the property from the City of Savannah, the Land Bank will market the property for development in accordance with the Land Bank Authority's affordability guidelines and development standards. Redeveloping the property will advance the Land Bank's ongoing revitalization efforts of providing affordable housing within the Laurel Grove/Railroad Neighborhood Area.

In accordance with our standard procedures, the Land Bank Authority will sell the property for no more than the estimated fair market value. Ninety percent of the sales proceeds will be returned to the City of Savannah, with the remaining ten percent retained by the Land Bank for operational costs and to reinvest in activities that benefit the City.
