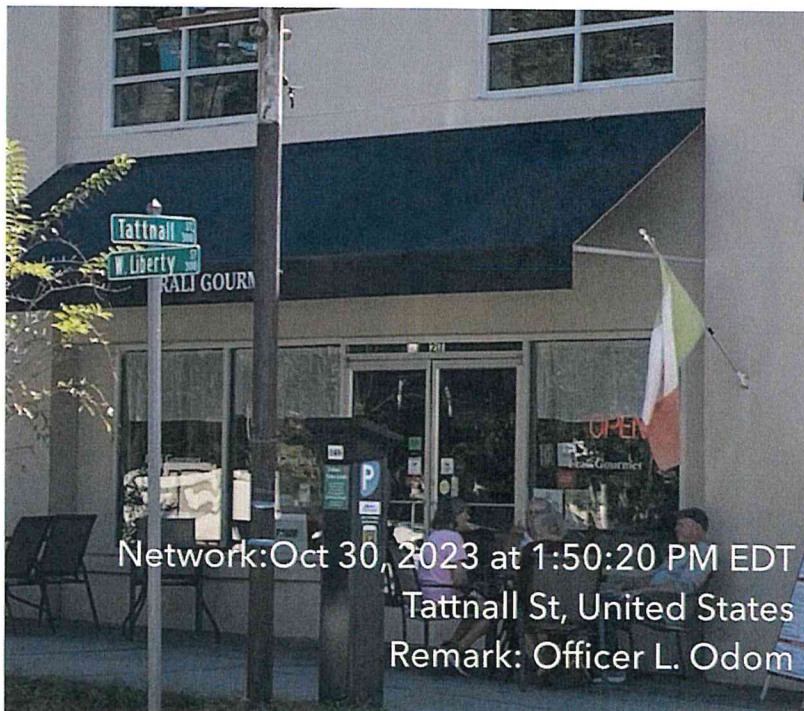

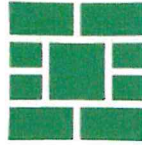

In reference to the application of **Frali Gourmet, LLC/ Alessandro Marra** requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **217 West Liberty St** (PIN [20031 16006](#)), I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant with Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol)** within the current **D-N (Downtown Neighborhood) zoning district**:

I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s)**:

- Restaurant is permitted by right.** The principal use classification *Restaurant*, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is allowed by right in the zoning district. Accessory alcohol sales by the drink in association with a restaurant is permitted by right. The parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District.
- Is Not Permitted
- Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen
- Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol) is permitted as a Limited Use with Standards.** Use is limited to on-premises consumption only. The property is located in the open container zone as provided in Sec. 6-1214.
- Is Permitted as a Non-conforming Use

Further, I have determined that **Parking** at the property:

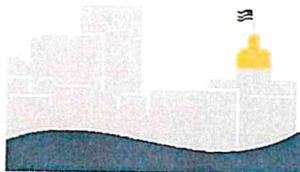
- The parking is exempt/met. (Pre-existing use)**
- The proposed use(s) are deficient in the parking standards.
