

The petitioner is requesting a new business licensing of a Class C23 SS (restaurant) for sale of on-premises consumption of malt beverages and wine with Sunday sales at Be Careful What You Think About, LCC located at 220 East 41st Street.

A review of the criminal history of Natasha Gaskill, to be found on file with the Alcohol Beverage Compliance Unit, revealed no disqualifying information as outlined in the City of Savannah Code of Ordinances, Section 6-1207, b.6.
