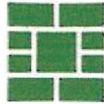

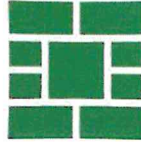

In reference to the application of **Russell Goeken / Cafe Taureau**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **3129 Bull St, (PIN 20088 03001)** I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant with Retail consumption dealer (on premises consumption of alcohol)** within the current **TC-1 Zoning District**:

- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use:

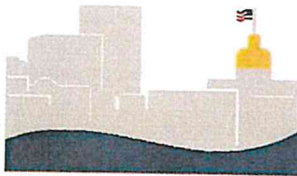



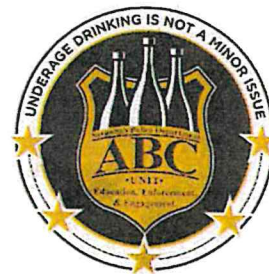
The purpose of this memorandum is to submit recommendations effective **11/6/2023**. The following information concerns the Alcohol Business Applicant, **Russell Goeken**.

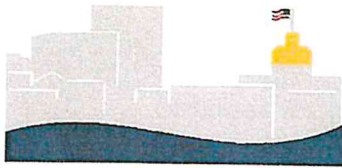
