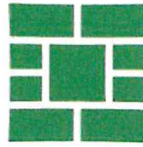

In reference to the application of **Los Socios LLC dba Orale Tacos** requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **36 Martin Luther King Blvd** (PIN 20016 16005) I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant** with **Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol)** within the current Downtown-Central Business District (D-CBD) zoning district:

I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s)**:

- Is Permitted by Right:** The principal use classification *Restaurant*, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is allowed by right in the zoning district. Accessory alcohol sales by the drink in association with a restaurant is permitted by right. The parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District.
- Is Not Permitted
- Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen:
- Is Permitted as a Limited Use with Standards
- Is Permitted as a Nonconforming Use

Additionally, I have determined that the **Proposed Use**:

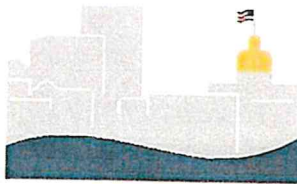
- Is an Existing use/occupancy, but new ownership, management or request.
- Is a new use/occupancy.**

Further, I have determined that **Parking** at the property:

- The parking requirement is met or exempt.**
- The proposed use(s) are deficient in the parking standards

Additionally, I have determined that the **Location** has:

- Zoning Ordinance violations that need to be corrected prior to the issuance of the Alcoholic Beverage License

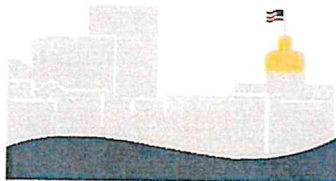
