

In reference to the application of **Sunzhu Ye, T/A Sushi Kingdom** requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **7804 Abercorn St, Ste #63-A** (PIN 20559 01004), I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant with Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol)**, within the current B-C (Community Business) zoning district:

I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s)**:

Is Permitted by Right: The principal use classification, **Restaurant**, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is permitted by right in the said zoning district. The parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District.

Is Not Permitted

Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen

Is Permitted as a Limited Use with Standards: Accessory Alcohol Sales by the Drink in Association with a Restaurant is permitted by right in B-C zoning district. Alcohol sales are limited to on-premises consumption only.

Is Permitted as a Non-conforming Use




