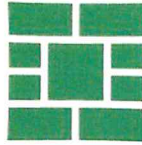

In reference to the application of **Karnjana Sirimatuross, SUNG LLC dba Sushi - Thai Savannah**, requesting an alcoholic beverage license at **317 W Broughton St** (PIN 20016 24005) I have determined that the **Proposed Use, Restaurant with *Retail consumption dealer (on-premises consumption of alcohol)*** within the current Downtown Central Business District (D-CBD) zoning district.

I have determined that the **Proposed Use(s)**:

- Is Permitted by Right:** The principal use classification *Restaurant*, as defined in Article 13 of the zoning ordinance, is allowed by right in the zoning district. Accessory alcohol sales by the drink in association with a restaurant is permitted by right. The parcel is not within the boundaries of an Alcohol Density Overlay District. However, the property is in the Open Container Zone.
- Is Not Permitted
- Requires a Special Use Permit from The Mayor and Aldermen:
- Is Permitted as a Limited Use with Standards:
- Is Permitted as a Pre-Existing Use

Further, I have determined that **Parking** at the property:

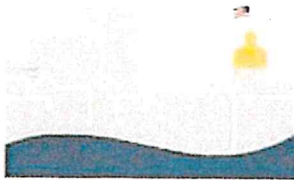
- The parking is exempt / met (Downtown Parking Exempt).**

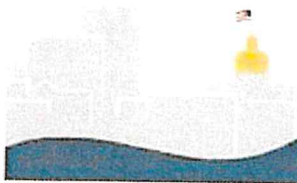
