- 1) What days of the week is my business open? What are the Hours of Operation?  
Wednesday 11:00am – 9:00pm  
Thursday 11:00am – 9:00pm

Saturday 11:00am – 9:00pm  
Sunday 12:00pm – 9:00pm
- 2) What measures and procedures are in place to address crowd management both inside & outside the premises?  
Managers on duty physically monitor the number of people inside the building to be sure we are under allowed capacity at all times.
- 3) Where do patrons park when they are at your establishment?  
There is no private parking available. Patrons park in paid parking lots on River Street, metered parking spaces or municipal garages.
- 4) How does establishment control who comes in & out of the business?  
Directional signage (Entrance, Exit), Management monitors people in business at all times.
- 5) Do you use Security Guards?  
No, security guards are not used (Door attendants may be used for crowd control on St. Patrick's Day weekend if needed).
- 5a) Do you use Off-Duty SPD officers?  
No, Off-Duty SPD officers are not used at any time.

**6) What is the procedure for combating underage consumption of alcoholic beverages?**

We adhere to the City of Savannah Ordinance requiring newly hired employees to complete a certified alcohol training program and obtain proof of completion within 7 days of their hire date.

**6a) How is age calculated by servers & bartenders?**

Age is calculated in their head and signage is posted indicating the date that someone would have been born on/after to be 21 years old.

**7) Does business allow patrons under 21 years of age? Yes. Business is primarily a restaurant. Business does not transition to 21 & over at any time.**

**7a) What is the procedure for identifying people 21 & over? Anyone serving alcohol is required to card every patron who orders an alcoholic beverage regardless of age. Only one drink is allowed per ID presented.**

**8) What measures are in place to combat the risk of fire?**

All employees are trained on fire safety and proper operation of all equipment. Additional training pertaining to electrical hazards is in place to prevent injury and fires.

**9) What policies or procedures are in place to manage emergencies?**

We have a written emergency plan including evacuation. Fire extinguisher & fire safety information is received when an employee is hired. Employee signature is obtained to acknowledge understanding of this training.
