  - No we do not , the camera system is on a 30 day cycle .

Where do your patrons park when they're at your establishment?

- There is so no designated parking area for patrons. Patrons are welcomed to legally park on the street in front of or across the store.

- Out of the two front doors of the store only one is unlocked and allowed to be entered by patrons. We allow all to enter, but we do state they must have shoes and a shirt on to enter the premises.
- There are 2 signs stating that customers and patrons will be monitored by cameras, one located by the front door and one located by the register .

- All staff members will be trained to card/ID all patrons who wish to purchase alcohol and to check the calendar verify age.

- All staff members who are authorized to work in the kitchen has been trained to use the equipment properly.

- There are also two fire extinguishers located in store in case of an actual fire , one at the front door and one at the back door
