

PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN

Purpose

This Public Safety Plan outlines the procedures Kabob and Kabob LLC will follow to ensure the safe and responsible sale of alcoholic beverages and to maintain a safe environment for customers, employees, and the surrounding community.

Hours of Operation

The restaurant operates Monday through Sunday from 11:00 AM to 9:00 PM. Alcoholic beverages will only be sold and consumed during normal business hours.

Customer Entry, Exit, and Surveillance

The business has two customer entrances located at the front of the restaurant and one rear service door used for employees and deliveries. The establishment maintains three security cameras covering the front entrance area, the interior dining/counter area, and the exterior area facing the shopping center parking lot. Camera footage is recorded to a storage device and can also be accessed by management through a mobile device. Footage is maintained for security purposes and may be provided to law enforcement when legally required.

Parking Lot Monitoring

The parking lot is part of a shared shopping center and is not owned or leased by Kabob and Kabob LLC. The parking area serves neighboring businesses, including a Chinese restaurant and a nail salon. Management and staff will monitor activity in the immediate area when possible and report suspicious or unsafe activity to law enforcement when necessary.

Access Control and Security

Management and staff will monitor customer activity throughout business hours. The rear service door is restricted to employees and authorized deliveries. All doors will remain secured when the business is closed.

Alcohol Service and Identification Verification

The establishment allows individuals of all ages to enter the premises. Identification will be checked when a patron requests to purchase or is being served an alcoholic beverage. All customers who appear under the age of 30 will be required to present a valid government-issued photo identification before being served alcoholic beverages. Staff will verify age, photograph, and expiration date. Employees will verify a customer's age by performing a mental calculation using the

customer's date of birth and the current date to ensure the customer is at least 21 years of age before any alcoholic beverage is served. Alcoholic beverages will only be sold or served to individuals who are 21 years of age or older. Customers who fail to provide valid identification will not be served alcoholic beverages.

Employee Responsibility

Management and employees are responsible for maintaining a safe environment and ensuring compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws regarding alcohol sales. Any disruptive, disorderly, or unlawful conduct will be addressed immediately and law enforcement will be contacted when appropriate. The business does not employ private security personnel. Management and employees will monitor customer activity, restaurant entrances and exits, and security camera footage throughout operating hours to help maintain a safe environment and promptly address any safety concerns, disruptive behavior, or unlawful conduct.

Fire Prevention and Emergency Procedures

The establishment maintains three fire extinguishers, with one located in the dining area and two located in the kitchen area. The kitchen is equipped with a commercial hood suppression system designed to help prevent and suppress cooking-related fires. The restaurant also operates two grills, one stove, and two fryers. All fire prevention equipment, cooking equipment, and suppression systems will be routinely inspected, cleaned, tested, and maintained in accordance with applicable fire safety requirements. Fire extinguishers will be maintained in accordance with applicable fire safety requirements. Emergency exits and walkways will remain clear and unobstructed. Employees will assist customers in safely evacuating the premises during an emergency and will contact emergency services when necessary. Staff will cooperate fully with police, fire, EMS, and other emergency personnel.

Commitment to Public Safety

Kabob and Kabob LLC is committed to operating responsibly, promoting public safety, preventing underage drinking, and maintaining compliance with all alcohol licensing requirements established by the City of Savannah and the State of Georgia.
