1. *Identification of days and hours of operation.*

Monday -Saturday 8:30am-8:00pm

Sunday 11:00am – 6:00pm (no sampling/complimentary services on Sunday)

2. *Specific measures and procedures to address crowd management, both within and outside the premises.*

Nelly's Grocery & Wine Bar is designed as a small-format grocery store with limited seating and wine service. The establishment will monitor occupancy levels to ensure a safe and comfortable environment for customers.

Staff will:

- Maintain clear aisles and exits at all times.
- Monitor customer flow during wine samplings/complimentary services and special events.
- Politely address disruptive behavior and ask individuals to leave if necessary.
- Post "No Loitering" signs near entrances and outdoor gathering areas.
- Utilize five security cameras covering entrances, exits, and, retail areas.
- Camera one will be located in the back office area above back door.
- Camera two will be located in the left corner upon store entry facing checkout area.
- Camera three will be located behind checkout wall/above pantry shelving.
- Camera four will be located in back corner, window side behind checkout wall.
- Camera five will be located adjacent to checkout area in upper corner above arch walls.
- Maintain adequate staffing during peak hours and special events.
- Chanel Parker and Stanton Parker (sparker2.sp@gmail.com or 913-710-6198) will be the only people with access to cameras and camera settings.

Any lines that form outside the premises will be managed by staff to ensure pedestrian walkways remain clear.

3. *Identification of any parking areas either owned or controlled by the licensee.*

We do not currently own or control any parking areas. All parking will be public parking.

4. *Means of controlling access to the premises and parking areas.*

Access to the premises will be controlled through designated public entrances. Any back door entrances will be reserved for owners/lease holders with access to electronic deadbolt.

All other staff and customers will access the public entrance and those measures include:

- Staff presence during operating hours
- Security camera monitoring of entrances
- Clearly posted store policies
- Exterior lighting to improve visibility and safety.
- Chanel Parker and Stanton Parker will be the only individuals with access to deadbolt codes.

5. *Security Staffing.*

Due to the small size and nature of the business, dedicated security guards will not be routinely employed.

Management and staff will monitor customer activity during operating hours and special events

If larger wine samplings/complimentary services or community events are held, additional personnel or off-duty security officers may be contracted as needed.

6. *Specific measures and procedures to combat underage consumption of alcoholic beverages.*

Nelly's Grocery & Wine maintains a strict zero-tolerance policy regarding underage alcohol sales and consumption. Measures include:

- Checking valid government-issued identification for all alcohol purchases.
- Training all employees on Georgia alcohol sales laws and responsible beverage service practices.
- Employees will perform mental math when evaluating if a customer is of age to purchase alcohol.
- Refusing alcohol sales when valid identification cannot be provided.
- Refusing sales to intoxicated individuals.
- Requiring age verification for all wine samplings/complimentary services and alcohol-related events.
- Maintaining employee accountability through documented training procedures.

7. *Specific measures and procedures to combat the risk of fire.*

To reduce fire risks, Nelly's Grocery & Wine Bar will:

- Maintain all fire extinguishers in accordance with local fire code requirements.
- There will be one fire extinguisher within Nelly's Grocery and Wine, located to the right of the public entry front doors along the wall.
- Keep exits clearly marked and unobstructed.
- Conduct regular inspections of electrical equipment and appliances.
- Prohibit smoking inside the establishment.
- Train employees on fire prevention and emergency response procedures.
- Maintain compliance with all Savannah Fire Department regulations and inspections.

8. *Discussion of matters related to managing emergencies, including fire, evacuation tactics, assignment of specific emergency management duties to personnel, coordination with public safety officers and emergency medical matters.*

In the event of an emergency, employees will be trained to:

- Immediately notify emergency services by calling 911.
- Direct customers to the nearest safe exit.
- Assist individuals requiring additional help during evacuation.
- Follow established evacuation procedures and gather at a designated meeting location outside the building.
- The designated meeting location will be on the sidewalk on Indian Street directly across from the Front entrance of Nelly's Grocery and Wine.
- Coordinate with police, fire, and EMS personnel upon arrival.

Management will assume responsibility for:

- Contacting emergency responders.
- Accounting for staff members.
- Providing information requested by emergency personnel.
- Communicating with property management when necessary.

9. *Where applicable, discussion of measures the licensee will undertake to visibly distinguish between patrons under and over the age of 21.*

While Nelly's Grocery & Wine is open to customers of all ages for grocery shopping, only individuals age 21 and older may purchase or consume alcoholic beverages.

For wine samplings/complimentary services and alcohol-related events:

- Valid government-issued identification will be checked before participation.
- Event attendees who are 21 and older may receive a wristband or stamp when appropriate.
- Staff will continuously monitor alcohol service areas to ensure compliance with state law.
