1. Identification of days and hours of operation.

Monday through Sunday: Open from 10-5:30. We understand that we are not allowed to serve complimentary plastic glass of champagne on Sundays. Days open are subject to change based on scheduled classes.

2. Specific measures and procedures to address crowd management, both within and outside the premises.

We have a franchise model that gives us a timeline to ensure that everyone makes their perfume in the 90 minute slot. Our classes are limited to 12-14 people. We do not have "No Loitering" We plan to install around 4-6 cameras and only the owners will have access to the cameras. Carolyn Sanford 985-519-4008 and Dayton Pietsch 318-525-5615. No cover charge and we have no transitional period.

3. Identification of any parking areas either owned or controlled by the licensee.

4. Means of controlling access to the premises and parking areas.

We have online booking and also accept walk ins if the class is not full. We do not control any parking areas as there are no public lots near us.

5. Security Staffing.

6. Specific measures and procedures to combat underage consumption of alcoholic beverages.

We will offer one 6 ounce plastic glass of complimentary champagne to people who complete the class. We will check IDs and if the person is underage we will offer a plastic glass of non alcoholic champagne. The employee shall use mental math to verify the patron is 21 or older.

7. Specific measures and procedures to combat the risk of fire.

We will have 2 or more fire extinguishers in the front showroom. We will also have a fire extinguisher in the back storage room. We also have a fire proof cabinet to store all of our perfume alcohol.

8. *Discussion of matters related to managing emergencies, including fire, evacuation tactics, assignment of specific emergency management duties to personnel, coordination with public safety officers and emergency medical matters.*

We will have at least 3 combo emergency exit signs on the premises. We have an exit on 7 w York street and another exit on 7 w York Lane. We will ensure that all staff members are aware to trigger the building fire alarm system and also call 911. The staff member teaching the classes will have the responsibility of getting the patrons out of the establishment and the front desk person will be responsible for calling authorities and triggering alarm system.

9. *Where applicable, discussion of measures the licensee will undertake to visibly distinguish between patrons under and over the age of 21.*

We allow people of all ages to enter. All patrons who wish to receive the complimentary 6 ounce champagne pour will be required to present a valid government-issued photo ID. Staff will verify that the patron is 21 years of age or older before any alcohol is served. Patrons who are verified will be marked at check in by a staff member. We will mark the patron on the check in list with a highlighter or some other clear indication that ID has been checked. No alcohol will be provided to individuals under the age of 21.
