

King Oliver's Creole Jazz Alcohol Security Plan v.2

Place of Origin: 514 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd Savannah, GA 31401

Hours of Operation: Monday-Saturday 1:00pm-10:00pm

Crowd Management inside the establishment: All people attempting to enter must present their ID to a security guard who will then determine whether they are twenty one (21) years of age or older. There are twelve (12) video surveillance cameras recording 24 hours a day inside the establishment.

Crowd management outside: There are four (4) additional cameras outside. The surrounding parking lot is clearly marked with signage such as "No Loitering" and "Customer Parking Only. All Violators will be Towed at Owner's Expense."

Measures to combat underage consumption of alcoholic beverages: Servers, bartenders, and security guards are trained to ask all customers who request an alcoholic beverage for their ID, and then to ensure that the customer is 21 years of age or older before serving them an alcoholic beverage. Additionally, patrons age 21 or older will be issued a wristband and/or hand stamp to distinguish them from patrons under 21.

Measures to combat the risk of fire or injuries due to fire: All fire exits are clearly marked with battery powered exit signs, crashbar doors, and a clear, unobstructed path to the exit. All staff are trained in using the fire extinguishers in case of emergencies, and are well-versed in the next steps to take in case the fire cannot be extinguished by staff. Additionally, all staff are trained to remain calm during an emergency and direct patrons to the nearest safe exit. The staff is instructed to call 911 immediately after safely exiting the building; this is explained in further detail in our "**Safety Plan**".
