

Security Plan

1. Identification of days and hours of operation

Lunch and Dinner

Monday - Sunday

11:00 – 10:00

2. Specific measures and procedures to address crowd management both inside and outside the premises.

The restaurant is located at 11412 and 11414 Abercorn Street and we have never experience a problem with crowd management. We maintain the number of patrons based upon City Fire Marshall guidelines. There are 5 security cameras located inside and 2 cameras outside the front of the building and 2 cameras outside the rear of the building. There are no “No Loitering” signs outside of building.

3. Identification of all parking areas owned or controlled by the establishment are clearly marked.

Patron parking is permitted in the parking area directly in front of the restaurant. Since the restaurant is in a strip shopping area, the parking area is shared with other businesses.

4. Means of controlling access to the premises and parking area.

There is a double door entrance to the restaurant and the parking lot can be viewed from the inside. Security cameras can also be used to view the parking area and entrance way.

5. Security Staffing

There are no security guards on site.

6. Measures used to combat underage consumption of alcohol beverages.

- a. All patrons purchasing alcohol must display an up-to-date form of identification to verify that they are 21 years old or older.
- b. A daily chart is posted with the dated in which a person is 21 or older is displayed. This is not calculated in one's head
- c. All servers and managers are required to complete an alcohol awareness course.

7. Measures used to distinguish between patrons who are over and under the age of 21, where applicable.

Persons under the age of 21 are permitted to enter the establishment, but cannot consume alcohol. All patrons ordering an alcohol beverage are required to show proof of age using an approved identification card. This proof of age is confirmed when the individual orders the first drink. There are no wrist bands /hand stamps or cards to indicate a person's age. There are no scanners nor does the seller enter the date of birth in a POS system. There will be a clock showing the date on which a person is born once the alcohol permit is granted.

8. Measures and procedures to combat the risk of fire.

The exhaust hood system is checked by the Savannah Fire Marshall on a periodical schedule. No smoking or open flame is allowed in the restaurant.

Entry and exit doors have been approved by the Savannah Fire Marshall's office. Staff is trained to cooperate with all local enforcement agencies.

9. Discuss matters related to managing emergencies, such as fires, evacuation tactics, assignments of employee duties during emergencies, and coordination with public safety: In an event of an emergency how is your staff trained to evacuate patrons? Do certain employees have certain duties during emergencies? How does your establishment contact / work with police and EMS during an emergency?

The building is a single story structure with two double door exits in the front and a single door exit in the rear. The kitchen staff will exit out of the single door in the rear of the building. The staff will guide patrons out of the two double door exits in front of the building.
