

## **Public Safety Plan – Operational Plan**

Q1. Identification of days and hours of operation.

A1. The store will be open from 7AM to 10Pm everyday.

Q2. Specific measures and procedures to address crowded management both inside and outside the premise.

A2. We have one entrance and 1 emergency exit door. Every customer coming in and out will be coming from the same door.

Q3. Identification of any parking areas owned or controlled establishments.

A3. We have posted no loitering signs posted on the property. We have 12 security cameras inside the building and 10 cameras outside the building. We have designated parking spaces for all the guests coming inside the gas station. We have 4 fueling pumps at which they can part and get gas.

Q4. Means of controlling access to the premises and parking area:

A4. This is not a private parking. It is open to all public considering it's a gas station.

Q5. Security Staffing.

A5. We do not have security guard.

Q6. Measures used to combat underage consumption of Alcohol

A6. We have posted signs on the doors and at the counter stating we ID everyone and anyone purchasing alcohol and tobacco. we have a digital calculator that calculates the age of 21 on the sale of sale so employees don't have to do mental math. We also have a scanner that will ask before selling alcohol and tobacco if the customer is over the age of 21.

Q7. Measures used to distinguish between patrons who are over and under 21, where applicable.

A7. We allow patrons under the age of 21 and we ID them if purchasing alcohol or tobacco. We ID them every time the new sale starts when purchasing alcohol or tobacco.

Q8. Measures and procedures to combat the risk of fire.

A8. We have fire extinguishers inside the building and outside.

Q9. Discuss matters related to managing emergencies, such as fire, evacuation tactics, assignment of employee duties during emergencies, and coordination with public safety.

A9. We have at least 1 person and 2 people in the evening at all times. We call 911 in the event of any emergency and a panic button located under the counter. We have had an emergency exit door at the back of the building that has a sign stating it's an emergency door so customers can use the exit in case of an emergency.
