Applicants should also type out the question they are answering OR answer the question using complete sentences.** Upon review of the Security Plan by SPD applicants may be asked to provide additional information (in writing) before the Security Plan can be approved.

Food services will stop when business closes.

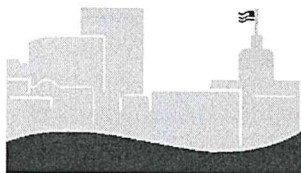
- 3) What is the distinction between the day and night business model?
