

Street Naming Request- Extension of "Perry Lane" to replace "Normandy Street"

Purpose

As a general policy, the Mayor and Aldermen find that public property should be named after its principal function, location, or historical reference; however, significant community events, organizations or well-known persons with important contributions to the community, state or nation may deserve public recognition, which may occur by way of naming or renaming public rights-of-way or facilities. In other cases, naming may change to prevent public confusion and assist in emergency service, commerce, and functionality.

Proposed Name: East Perry Lane (extension of direct connecting roadway)
Location: East Perry Lane from Pulaski Street to Truman Parkway



Naming Request Justification

A parcel located off an unopen right of way referred to as "Normandy Street' on some public maps and GIS systems, runs perpendicular to an existing street called East Perry Lane. The Street name appears on some maps to change without any geographical or traffic reference, causing confusion. Parts of the current road sometimes called "Normandy Street" are dirt, unpaved, and infrequently used by the public. This public confusion will increase as parcels located on this roadway continue to develop.

The Petitioner requests the street naming be formally updated to consistently be titled Perry Lane. (See Exhibit A.)

The update will prevent public confusion as Perry Lane extends directly east towards the rail road tracks. As part of development activity on 1147 E President Street, the extension of Perry Lane east is being improved, paved, and becoming accessible to the public. The permanent clarification of the street name and extension will ease public confusion.

Historical Review

Please see the attached historical review conducted by the City of Savannah Municipal Archives Department which in summary shows that Normandy Street was renamed in 1953 along with many others City Street names that had become duplicative. This effort was done to have prevent public confusion.



Section 4-1103 – Renaming of public property, facilities or streets.

- (a) All requests to rename public property shall be made in writing and directed to the attention of the City Manager. Such requests shall include:
 - (1) In the instance of a street or roadway:
 - (A) A supporting petition signed by not less than 75 percent of all property owners adjacent to the public right-of-way;
 - (B) The present official name of the street;
 - (C) The proposed new name;
 - (D) The specific location of the street or roadway;
 - (E) The name, address and telephone number of the person requesting the name change;
 - (F) A statement of reasons supporting the renaming request;
 - (G) A thorough discussion regarding the history of the right-of-way, including all prior names associated therewith; and
 - (H) An endorsement by the current Mayor, an at-large alderman or the alderman representing the district in which the right-of-way is located.







Hello,

I have found the ordinance that renamed this street to Normandy Street – it happened in early 1953 (thought I didn't find the second reading and adoption?). There is no reason given, but at the same time many streets were renamed, including the South American named streets, and several with European city names like Inverness, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Guernsey so it seems like international names were the trend they were going with for this large batch of street names.

Ordinance read in Council for the first time February 6th, 1953.

BY THE COMMITTEE ON STREETS, BUILDING AND ZOWING

AN ORDINANCE

TO CHANGE THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREE:S AND PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF SAVANNAH SO AS TO AVOID DUPLICATIONS IN STREET NAMES WHICH NOW EXIST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same, that the following named streets and public ways in the City of Savannah be changed in the following manner, so as to avoid duplications in such names presently existing:-

PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL - FEBRUARY 6th, 1953

LAUREL STREET, extending from Jones Street to Bolton Street in Jenkins and Meyer Wards, shall be known as MINNESOTA STREET.

LAURER STREET, extending from Waters Avenue to William Street in Bouhan Ward, shall be known as ECUADOR STREET.

LAWTON ROAD, extending east and west in Hardee and Heyward Wards, shall be known as NCRMANDY STREET.
