

A RESOLUTION TO RE-DESIGNATE THE “PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE” AND “MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. AND MONTGOMERY STREET” ENTERPRISE ZONES AS QUALIFYING ENTERPRISE ZONES PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 36-88-6 FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to state enabling legislation, the Mayor and Aldermen have established certain Enterprise Zones known, *inter alia*, as the “Pennsylvania Avenue” and “Martin Luther King, Jr. and Montgomery Street” Enterprise Zones; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, enterprise zones expire after 10 years unless re-designated and extended by action of the Mayor and Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen find that the “Pennsylvania Avenue” and “Martin Luther King, Jr. and Montgomery Street” Enterprise Zones currently meet the criteria for enterprise zone re-designation pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-88-6; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen find that the purpose for both the “Pennsylvania Avenue” and “Martin Luther King, Jr. and Montgomery Street” Enterprise Zones compels their respective re-designation and continuation for an additional ten-year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SAVANNAH hereby re-designate the Pennsylvania Avenue Enterprise Zone (Section 8-10008) and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard and Montgomery Street Enterprise Zone (Section 8-10009) duly qualified enterprise zones for a period of 10 years from the date appearing below.
