

**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE DESIGNATED OFFICIALS TO
PROVIDE WRITTEN VERIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR SOLID
WASTE HANDLING PERMITS**

WHEREAS, the Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act of 1990, as amended (the “Act”), requires that facilities seeking a solid waste handling permit obtain written verification of compliance with local zoning or land use ordinances and written verification of consistency with the local, multijurisdictional, or regional solid waste management plan (OCGA § 12-8-24(g)(1)); and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that written verification may be executed by an administrative official or employee of the host local government only if that person has been authorized by ordinance or resolution; otherwise the Act requires that written verification shall be executed by the chief elected official of the governing authority of the host local government (OCGA § 12-8-24(g)(2)); and

WHEREAS, the Director and Assistant Director of the City of Savannah Department of Planning, Zoning, and Urban Design possess a thorough understanding of the City’s zoning and land use ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Savannah Ten-Year Solid Waste Management Plan 2025-2035 (the “Plan”), adopted by the Aldermen on August 13, 2026, establishes a procedure for the City Manager or Assistant City Manager to determine consistency of proposed solid waste handling facilities with the Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to the State of Georgia’s Solid Waste Management Act (OCGA § 12-8-24(g)(2)), the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to sign letters (i) verifying whether a proposed solid waste handling facility or a proposed expansion of an existing solid waste handling facility is consistent with the Ten-Year Solid Waste

Management Plan for 2025-2035 and (ii) verifying that such proposed facility or proposed facility expansion complies with the City of Savannah Zoning Ordinance.
