1. Identification of days and hours of operation.

Monday - Thursday 10 am to 10 pm, Friday and Saturday 10 am to 11:30 pm,
Sunday 12:30 pm to 7:30 pm

2. Specific measures and procedures to address crowd management, both within and outside the premises.

We do not have large crowds coming to the store. The parking lot has a few parking spaces for multiple stores.

To prevent crowds from gathering outside the establishment, we ask anyone loitering in front of the store to leave.

We have 16 cameras, two outside and 14 inside. Victoria Domingo has access to the camera footage, cell phone number 770-633-8896.

The business is a retail store; there is no cover charge.

We do not have a transitional period during which we operate differently.

3. Identification of any parking areas either owned or controlled by the

licensee. We do not control or own any parking spaces. There are a few parking spaces in front of the store that are available to patrons visiting any of the stores in the strip mall. It is a small strip mall with three businesses facing Ogeechee Rd.

4. Means of controlling access to the premises and parking areas.

All patrons must be 21 years or older, and if a child comes in, they must be accompanied by an adult. We do have signs posted stating that 21 years or older can enter the premises.

5. Security Staffing.

We do not use security guards or off-duty Savannah Police Officers.

6. Specific measures and procedures to combat underage consumption of alcoholic beverages.

We verify a customer's age by requesting government-issued ID. We use mental math to verify a customer's age.

7. Specific measures and procedures to combat the risk of fire.

All employees have taken the OSHA Fire Safety Course.

We have a fire extinguisher that is tested every year.

Employees are responsible for evacuating any patrons during a fire and following evacuation procedures.

Employees are responsible for calling 911 in an emergency.

8. Discussion of matters related to managing emergencies, including fire, evacuation tactics, assignment of specific emergency management duties to personnel, coordination with public safety officers and emergency medical matters.

There is an Exit Plan. There are two exits on the property. One in the front and one in the back. Both are visible and marked.

We also have an alarm system that will notify the police in case of an emergency.

Employees are responsible for evacuating any patrons during a fire and following evacuation procedures.

We request government-issued ID to confirm a person's age. We use mental math to verify that they are 21 years of age or older.
