

AN ORDINANCE
TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND DIVISION II, PART 4, PUBLIC
SERVICES, CHAPTER 7, INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT,
ARTICLE A, GENERAL ADMINISTRATION, TO AMEND
THE COMMISSION PURCHASING BOARD'S PURCHASING
THRESHOLD; TO PROVIDE FOR EFFECTIVE DATES; TO REPEAL
ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, Georgia, in regular meeting of Council assembled and pursuant to the lawful authority thereof:

SECTION 1: That Article A, General Administration, of Chapter 7, International Airport, of Part 4, Public Services, of Division II of the Code of the City of Savannah be amended by deleting Section 4-7109, Commission purchasing board, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 4-7109. Commission purchasing board.

The airport commission has established and shall continue to maintain a Commission Purchasing Board for purchases of materials, goods, equipment, supplies, services (other than professional services), or construction with a value or cost greater than \$5,000.00 but no greater than \$50,000.00. The Commission Purchasing Board shall consist of the Executive Director and four airport commission staff members appointed by the Executive Director. Three members of the Commission Purchasing Board shall constitute a quorum provided one of them is the Executive Director or his/her designee. Purchases of any such materials, goods, equipment, supplies, services or construction for the airport commission with a value or cost greater than \$5,000.00 but no greater than \$50,000.00 shall be made through a system of procurement adopted by the Commission Purchasing Board and, insofar as it is practicable, in accordance with by informal competitive quotations, and a record of such quotations shall be maintained in the airport commission files for a period of no less than three years. Purchases by the airport commission of such materials, goods, equipment, supplies, services or construction with a value or cost greater than \$50,000.00 shall be made through a system of procurement adopted by the airport commission, and such system shall include formal competitive bidding unless such purchases are of an emergency nature or there is only one feasible source for the purchase, and a report of such purchases shall be made to the City of Savannah. Purchases of such materials, goods, equipment, supplies, services, or construction with a value or cost greater than \$50,000.00 shall be approved or ratified by the mayor and aldermen.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This amendment shall become effective upon the Mayor affixing his signature below.
