- 1. Identification of the days and hours of operation.
 - What days of the week are your business open for? 7 Days a week
 - For each day what time is your business open?
 - Sunday-Thurs noon-12pm

(Cover charge at the door starts, menu changes or kitchen closes, live entertainment starts, door person stops letting in under 21) (No loitering signs will be posted outside of the store to avoid gathering of crowd outside the store, and employees in the store will manage the crowd inside the store by giving them instructions when needed
- 3. Identification of any parking areas either owned or controlled by the licensee.
 - Where do your patrons park when they're at your establishment? The parking for our business is adjacent to our property line
- 4. Means of controlling access to the premises and parking areas.
 - How does your establishment control who comes in and out of the premises?
 - How does your establishment control who uses the parking area?

- 6. Specific measures and procedures to combat underage consumption of alcoholic beverages.

 - Do certain employees have certain duties during emergencies?
 - How does your establishment contact and work with police and EMS during an emergency? We will follow instructions from City of Savannah Police and emergency in any event of emergencies. There will be proper signs in the store for emergency exits
- 9. Where applicable, discussion of measures the licensee will undertake to visibly distinguish between patrons under and over the age of 21.
 - Does your establishment allow individuals under 21 years of age to enter? If so, how does your establishment identify and distinguish those 21 years of age and older from those 20 years of age and under? Be specific about the measures taken. Licensee will post the signs in the store that no alcohol will be sold to underage persons. They must show valid ID. Regardless of how young they look he/she will be asked for proper verification with photo.
