

SAFETY PLAN:

Burrito's Pantano will be open 7 days a week from 10 AM to 11 PM.

To maintain crowd control, we will limit the number of people inside the restaurant to 15 at any time. We will be installing no loitering signs and we have 6 cameras that record everything in the restaurant 24/7 and maintain 14 days of history

Since the restaurant is downtown, we do not provide any sort of parking

For access control, we have one entry into the building and this is monitored by a camera. As stated, we will limit the number of people in the restaurant to 15 at any one time

We do not see the need for security guards since the restaurant will only be serving beer and wine while the patrons eat

As is standard practice, all patrons in the restaurant will be asked to provide a valid form of identification in order to purchase alcohol. For reading the cards, we will have a sign posted stating which day you were born before in order to buy alcohol and the cashier will ID everyone and calculate the age in their head. We do not have servers so the cashier will be the control point on this.

Every patron will be asked for identification in order to purchase alcohol, no matter their age

Fire extinguishers are maintained in the building and the exit is clearly marked. In the event of an emergency, the staff has been instructed to get the patrons out of the building quickly through the entrance, call the police or fire department while vacating the building
