 Hotel is operational 7 days a week, 24hrs. Beer and wine will be available for sale from 11am-11pm

2. Specific measures and procedures to address crowd management, both within and outside the premises.

Only hotel registered guests will be allowed as patrons. No alcohol will be served at late hours which typically causes unruliness and crowd issues. There are 24 cameras through the property that cover the interior and 4 cameras that cover the exterior; these cameras are CCTV that has a hard drive and stores 30 days worth of data. Cameras and its data are accessible by management staff only. Customer check-in usually takes 2-3 mintues and most of time is completed via mobile app on their phone. Wine and Beer are served from a locked kiosk that can only be accessed by staff via security card.

 Entire parking lot adjacent to the hotel is controlled by the hotel. No loitering signs and tow away signs are installed.
- Means of controlling access to the premises and parking areas.
 Parking is free to guests, we do not control access. No loitering signs an

After 10pm hotel access is limited with Guest key card We have cameras through out the building and on the exterior.

5. Security Staffing.

We will not have security, we do not anticipate any crowd issues or over consumption. If the location, did have a need for security, we would most likely just shut down alcohol serving.

6. Specific measures and procedures to combat underage consumption of alcoholic beverages.

We will card all purchasers, In addition staff will be trained to monitor for overconsumption and potential abuse by underage customers. Front desk will handle the alcohol transactions and use POS systems that require DOB entry to verify age.

7. Specific measures and procedures to combat the risk of fire.

Hotel is fully spinklered with Central Fire Alarm. Exit routes are posted through out the hotel. Hotel staff/personal will follow fire safety plan, see attachement.
