1) Hours of Operation

7am – 8pm, Sunday through Saturday

2) Crowd Management

We will not exceed the Maximum Capacity of persons

We will limit the quantity of beverages sold per person

We will not have “no loitering” signs

We will have 6 security cameras inside with the footage available for two weeks.

We will implement the usage of a hand-held POS device to expedite ordering when a line of more than 10 people forms.

3) Parking

We have 8 reserved parking spaces in the parking garage for the building. This area is monitored with security cameras.

Customers have the option to also utilize public street parking

4) Parking Control

The private parking garage in the building is monitored with security cameras.

We will have reserved parking signs installed to identify our spaces for customer use only.

5) Security Guards

Based on our type of business, we will not employ Security Guards, or off-duty SPD officers.

6) Underage Consumption Measures and Age Distinguishing Measures

All beer/wine purchases will be required to show proper ID to employees who will be trained to impose this requirement in all instances of alcohol purchase.

Each carded transaction will use calculator/calculations to determine age basis.

No scanner

No DOB into the POS.

We allow customers of all ages to enter since it's a coffee shop. Only those purchasing beer/wine are subject to being carded.

No wrist bands/hand stamps

7) Fire Prevention Measures

We will enforce a "No Smoking" policy and there is no use of fire in the shop.

8) Managing Emergencies

All staff will be actively involved in evacuating patrons via the front, back and bi-fold doors in case of a fire. The Shift Leader will make a restroom sweep upon exit. Our alarm system will automatically contact the authorities and management/ownership will be notified and will coordinate with authorities.
