These security measures protect the City of Savannah from malicious malware that could prevent City operations if an event were to occur.</p> <p>This is a sole source procurement because Malwarebytes is the original provider of this software and is the only vendor that can perform maintenance and service its products. It is critical to have the support of the original provider when it is necessary. This contract was originally approved by Council on April 26, 2018 as an emergency procurement following the City of Savannah’s malware attack that year. The cost per year is \$25,000.
