SECTION I

INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

1.0 Submission Requirements:

1.1 The complete original proposal must be submitted in a sealed package and received in accordance with the instructions detailed in the cover letter. All proposals shall be marked **Voice and Data Leased Lines, RFP #10.157**. Proposers shall file all documents necessary to support their proposal and include them with their proposal. Proposers shall be responsible for the actual delivery of proposals during business hours to the address indicated in the cover letter. It shall not be sufficient to show that the proposal was mailed in time to be received before scheduled closing time.

1.2 **Proposal Format:** Proposals shall be submitted in the following format and include the following information.

- a) Detailed description of leased line voice and data capabilities as requested.
- b) Fee Proposals per instructions in Section III signed by responsible party
- c) Contact names of current users with phone numbers.
- d) Proposed Schedule of Minority and Women owned Business Participation and Non-Discrimination Statement.
- e) Contractor affidavit and agreement

1.3 It is the sole responsibility of the **PROPOSER** to assure that they have received the entire Request for Proposal.

1.4 Proposers will be notified in writing of any change in the specifications contained in this RFP.

1.5 No verbal or written information which is obtained other than through this RFP or its addenda shall be binding on the City of Savannah. No employee of the City of Savannah is authorized to interpret any portion of this RFP or give information as to the requirements of the RFP in addition to that contained in or amended to this written RFP document.

1.6 **Right of Rejection and Clarification:** The City of Savannah reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to request clarification of information from any proposer. The City of Savannah is not obligated to enter into a contract on the basis of any proposal submitted in response to this document.

1.7 **Request for Additional Information:** Prior to the final selection, proposers may

be required to submit additional information which the City may deem necessary to further evaluate the proposer's qualifications.

- 1.8 Denial of Reimbursement:** The City of Savannah will not reimburse proposers for any costs associated with the preparation and submittal of any proposal, or for any travel and/or per diem costs that are incurred.
- 1.9 Gratuity Prohibition:** Proposers shall not offer any gratuities, favors, or anything of monetary value to any official, employee, or agent of the City of Savannah for the purpose of influencing consideration of this proposal.
- 1.10 Right of Withdrawal:** A proposal may not be withdrawn before the expiration of ninety (90) days from the proposal due date.
- 1.11 Right of Negotiation:** The City of Savannah reserves the right to negotiate with the selected proposer the exact terms and conditions of the contract.
- 1.12 Right of Rejection of Lowest Fee Proposal:** The City of Savannah is under no obligation to award this project to the proposer offering the lowest fee proposal. Evaluation criteria included in this document shall be used in evaluating proposals.
- 1.13 Exceptions to the RFP:** Proposers may find instances where they must take exception with certain requirements or specifications of the RFP. All exceptions shall be clearly identified, and written explanations shall include the scope of the exceptions, the ramifications of the exceptions for the City of Savannah, and a description of the advantage to be gained or disadvantages to be incurred by the City as a result of these exceptions.
- 1.14 Indemnification:** Proposer, at its own expense and without exception, shall indemnify, defend and pay all damages, costs, expenses, including attorney fees, and otherwise hold harmless the City of Savannah, its employees, and agents, from any liability of any nature or kind in regard to the delivery of these services.
- 1.15 Rights to Submitted Material:** All proposals, responses, inquiries, or correspondence relating to or in reference to this RFP, and all reports, charts, and other documentation submitted by proposers shall become the property of the City of Savannah when received.
- 1.16 Basis of Award:** Proposals will be evaluated according to the following criteria and weight at a minimum:
 - a) Proposer's qualifications and experience, including support capabilities. (25 points)
 - b) Technical capabilities (25 points)

c) Fees (40 points)

d) References (10 points)

Proposals shall be evaluated by a Selection Committee. The Selection Committee may, at its option, request any or all proposers to provide on-site demonstrations of the proposed system.

1.17 Copies: One (1) unbound, printed and signed original and two identical, electronic copies on CD-ROM only of the proposal and supporting documents must be submitted in response to the RFP. All responses must relate to the specifications as outlined.

1.18 Contacts: Proposers must submit proposals in accordance with the instructions contained in this RFP. All requested information must be submitted with the proposal. 1.19 Submittal of Qualifications: Proposers should submit experience and qualifications as described below. Additional information may be submitted as appropriate to further describe vendor and provide product capabilities.

a) List of clients and contact names who are using proposed system.

b) Location and number of support personnel.

1.20 Contract: The contract between the City of Savannah and the contractor shall consist of (1) the Request for Proposal (RFP) and any amendments thereto, and (2) the proposal submitted by the contractor in response to the RFP. In the event of a conflict in language between the two documents referenced above, the provisions and requirements set forth and/or referenced in the RFP shall govern. However, the City of Savannah reserves the right to clarify any contractual relationship in writing with the concurrence of the contractor, and such written

clarification shall govern in case of conflict with the applicable requirements stated in the RFP or the contractor's proposal. In all other matters not affected by the written clarifications, if any, the RFP shall govern.

- 1.21 Termination of Contract:** The City of Savannah may cancel the contract at any time for breach of contractual obligations by providing the consultant with a written notice of such cancellation. Should the City of Savannah exercise its right to cancel the contract for such reasons, the cancellation shall become effective on the date as specified in the notice of cancellation sent to the contractor.
- 1.22 Compliance with Laws:** In connection with the furnishing of supplies or performance of work under the contract, the Consultant agrees to comply with the Fair Labor Standard Act, Equal Opportunity Employment Act, and all other applicable Federal and State laws, regulations, and executive orders to the extent that the same may be applicable and further agrees to insert the foregoing provision in all subcontracts awarded hereunder.

Proposers certify that all equipment, services and or goods provided to the City of Savannah comply with the Department of Justice ADA Title III Regulations.

- 1.23 Minority/Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Policy:** It is the policy of the City of Savannah that minority/women-owned business enterprises ("MWBE") be given fair opportunity to participate in the performance of services for the City, and that prime contractors utilize minority and women-owned subcontractors and suppliers to the fullest extent possible consistent with the efficient performance of the contract. The City of Savannah has established a NA % M/WBE goal for this project. The breakdown is as follows: NA% MBE, NA% Women Participation.

A "minority-owned business enterprise" is defined as a business concern that is (1) at least 51% owned, managed and controlled by one or more minority individuals, or, in the case of a publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock is owned by one or more minority individuals; and (2) whose daily business operations are managed and directed by one or more of the minority owners, and is certified by a certifying entity or verified as such by the City of Savannah. The ownership interest must be real and continuous and not created solely to meet the minority business or minority contractor provisions of this Policy.

A "woman-owned business enterprise" is defined as a business concern that is 1) at least 51% owned, managed, operated and controlled by one or more women who is not a member of a racial minority or in the case of publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock is owned by one or more women; and 2) whose daily business operations are managed and directed by one or more of the women owners and can be verified through certification. The ownership interest must be real, continuous, and not created solely to meet the women

business or women contractor provisions of this Policy.

The proposer shall also submit the attached notice of non-discrimination with their proposal and complete the participation schedule.

1.24 Employment Eligibility Verification and Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE):

As required under Senate Bill 529 – “Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act” of 2006, O.C.G.A. Section 2, Article 3 13-10-91, public employers, their contractors and subcontractors are required to verify the work eligibility of all newly hired employees through an electronic federal work authorization program. The Georgia Department of Labor has added a new Chapter 300-10-1, entitled "Public Employers, Their Contractors and Subcontractors Required to Verify New Employee Work Eligibility Through a Federal Work Authorization Program," to the Rules and Regulations of the State of Georgia. (See website: http://www.dol.state.ga.us/pdf/rules/300_10_1.pdf.)

The new rules designate the “Employment Eligibility Verification (EEV) Basic Pilot Program” operated by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Bureau of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security as the electronic federal work authorization program to be utilized for these purposes. O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia’s cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain “public benefits” are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the City are considered “public benefits.” Therefore, the successful bidder will be required to provide the Affidavit Verifying Status for City of Savannah Benefit Application prior to receiving any City contract. The affidavit is included as part of this bid package but is only required of the successful bidder.

1.25 Protest Procedure: A proposer who is aggrieved by the recommendation of the City Manager to award a contract may appeal the decision to the City Manager no later than 48 hours prior to the date the award recommendation is scheduled to be approved by City Council. Recommendations to Council are posted on the preliminary agenda on the City’s website generally on the Friday prior to the Council meeting date. It is the vendor’s responsibility to ascertain the City’s recommendation for award. The preliminary agenda may be accessed at <http://www.savannahga.gov/Cityweb/minutes.nsf/Agendas>. No consideration shall be given to protests received after the prescribed period for protests.

SECTION II

SCOPE OF WORK

- 2.0 Introduction/Purpose:** The City of Savannah would like to consolidate and improve both voice and data leased line connectivity in the following areas: current and future capacity, reliability, vendor services, and reporting.
- 2.1 Scope:** This project shall include providing leased line connectivity in the following areas: Voice Circuits, Data Circuits, Cable/DSL Modems, and Analog phone lines. Please see **Attachment A, 1-4**, for a list of all service locations with their address and leased line needs.
- 2.2 Voice Circuits:** The City currently has five (5) PRIs with 2000 DIDs, one (1) T1 circuit with two channels and 300 DIDs, and sixty-four (64) analog lines to for survivability of our VoIP solution provided by Level 3 Communications.

Provider shall be an authorized and licensed CLEC and distribute the PRIs as outlined in Attachment A. Each PRI shall be B8ZS-ESF, labeled and have smart jack terminations. Long distance service is required and the Provider shall state the availability of “caller ID” and “Calling Party Name and Number” features. Provider shall also port all existing DIDs (2000) as well as provide pricing for additional DIDs in 100 count increments.

The Provider shall include a digital, 8 channel, T1 circuit with a minimum of 400 DIDs for the City’s faxing needs. Provider shall port all existing DIDs (300) and provide pricing for additional DIDs in 100 count increments.

The Provider shall port the sixty-four (64) analog lines used for survivability of our VoIP phone system per **Attachment A-1**. The City will consider alternate proposals for providing survivability at these sites.

- 2.3 Data Circuits:** The City currently has 12 point-to-point T1 circuits with AT&T that all terminate at our old data center located at 132 East Broughton and will need to be relocated to our new Data Center, located at the Savannah Civic Center. The City will consider alternate proposals of equivalent or better bandwidth with lower latency in place of existing circuits. Vendor shall provide data on the actual bandwidth and latency for any alternate solutions. Vendor shall also provide different tiers of service and the cost of these tiers if applicable.

Additionally, the City has six other point-to-point T1 circuits that will not need to be relocated, but pricing should be provided in accordance with **Attachment A-2**. No alternate proposals will be considered for these circuits.

- 2.4 Cable/DSL Modems:** The City currently has 30 sites using a Comcast cable

modem and 12 sites using an AT&T DSL modem for connectivity with a minimum of two static IP addresses per **Attachment A-3**. Provider shall present a solution of equivalent or better bandwidth. Additionally, please provide different tiers of service and the cost of each of these tiers.

- 2.5 Analog Phone Lines:** The City currently has over 430 phone lines with AT&T at various locations per **Attachment A-4**. The Provider shall port all existing analog dial tone.
- 2.6 Capacity:** Describe your ability to add or reduce capacity for either or both data and voice services in each of the four categories of service mentioned above.
- 2.7 Performance Measurement and Reporting:** The City seeks the ability to access reports, charts, and trends on all applicable data and voice services in electronic format (i.e. long distance, bandwidth, etc) and be notified via email if utilization exceeds a pre-determined threshold. Please detail your ability to provide such reports and include samples.
- 2.8 Service Monitoring:** Describe your processes for monitoring data and voice communications that shall include but are not limited to alerting, action plans, and estimated response and recovery times.
- 2.9 Service Redirection and Recovery:** The PRIs shall be designed to automatically fail-over to each other in the event of a failure. Please describe your ability, process, and time involved relocating services to a temporary location and then restoring them back to the original location. Also, describe your ability to provide business continuity for our 311 call center in the event of a disaster.
- 2.10 Consolidated Billing:** Describe your ability to provide detailed billing on a single invoice for all services provided based on assigned Cost Centers. (City Departments) The monthly statement shall reference the City's Cost Centers and include a detail for all services at each location. The City shall be able to assign Cost Centers to individual DIDs, circuits, and services. (i.e. long distance) Describe the process to initially upload Cost Center, DID, and location information. Please include a sample invoice and screen shots if applicable to on-line account access.
- 2.11 Porting Numbers:** The selected Provider shall be responsible for all vendor coordination, scheduling, porting, and testing for the porting process. Please describe in detail the porting process and anticipated schedule for completion. Porting of all existing DIDs shall occur after hours and be scheduled in advance.
- 2.12 Account Maintenance:** The City expects the selected vendor to designate permanent support contacts for on-going maintenance and questions regarding

our account. Please describe in detail the process to request new service, report problems, and escalation procedures.

2.13 Pricing: Pricing should include all one-time cost, recurring monthly cost, and maintenance cost in accordance with the pricing schedule.

2.14 Award: It is the City's desire to have a single contract for all leased line services, but we reserve the right to award this RFP in whole or in part and to multiple providers.

2.15 Contract Period: This contract may be renewed for not more than four (4) additional twelve (12) month periods by mutual agreement of the contracting parties and the City of Savannah.

SECTION III
FEE PROPOSAL
